

**GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE 2011 NATLAND GOLF TOUR
GOLF TOURNAMENT SERIES**

(hereinafter referred to as “2011 NGT GTS”)

I.

Player nominations for individual tournaments

- I.1.** Tournaments are open to contractual partners of the Provider (hereinafter as “**partner**”).
- I.2.** Only invited players may take part in individual *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* tournaments. The Provider is entitled to ask players to present invitations.
- I.3.** The Partner is obliged to submit to the Provider a list of players who are to represent the Partner at individual *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* tournaments, no later than one (1) month prior to the beginning of the respective tournament (see the nomination template at the end of this appendix). The name list must include: first name and last name of the player, his/her company and position, registration number and contact information. Each foreign player must state their date of birth, HCP and the golf club of which he/she is a member. This data is uploaded on the server for registration purposes (hereinafter referred to as the “**player**”). Players who fail to provide this data will not be admitted to the tournament. Players will be informed about the upcoming tournament well in advance. Participants are invited by the Provider.
- I.4.** The Provider reserves the right to select players from the list provided by the Partner to individual *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* tournaments.
- I.5.** All nominated players must be registered with the Czech Golf Federation (*Česká golfová federace* (www.cgf.cz)). Only amateurs with HCP may take part in the *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* tournaments. Each foreign player must state their date of birth, HCP and the golf club of which he/she is a member. This data is uploaded on the server for registration purposes.
- I.6.** Mixed player categories are defined as follows:
- a. Champions**
- these are nominated by partners of the *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour*; their nomination is acknowledged by the Provider (i.e. clients of partner companies).
- b. Invitational**
- players who are employees of, or similarly related to, the partners or the provider of the *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* (i.e. partners, sponsors, flight purchases)
 - companions of invited players (in both categories)

- I.7. The score will be counted for players from both categories having an HCP of up to 54. Only players from the *Champions* group can advance to the finals of the *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour*.
- I.8. Under the Stableford scoring system, only the winners of HCP categories of individual tournaments of the *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* can advance to the finals. Under the Texas Scramble scoring system, the team with the lowest number of shots shall advance to the finals.

II.

2011 NATLAND Golf Tour Rules

- II.1. One 18-hole round is played in the categories stipulated by the Provider, pursuant to the rules of golf published on the website of the CGF (hereinafter referred to as the “**Rules of golf**”), competition regulations of the CGF and local rules.
- II.2. The competition includes the principle of HCP adjustment in all amateur categories.
- II.3. Individual rosters of the *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* tournaments are created the day before and published on the website of the Provider, i.e. www.natlandgolftour.cz.
- II.4. The schedule of individual *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* tournaments is defined by the respective roster. The tournament organiser, i.e. the Provider, and the main referee are authorised to make changes in the published official roster, so as to ensure fair play and the appropriate pace of the tournament.
- II.5. Final standings of individual *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* tournaments are published on the Provider’s website, i.e. www.natlandgolftour.cz within 12 hours from the official end of the tournament.
- II.6. Tournaments played under the **Stableford** scoring system are played pursuant to the Rules of golf, competition regulations of the CGF and local rules. Starting from holes number 1 and 10, players proceed in succession pursuant to the roster. The player with the highest score under the Stableford scoring system is declared the winner. In the case of a tied score between two leading players (unless otherwise decided by the CGF server) a sudden-death shootout shall decide; in the case of players finishing second (third..., etc.) the player having better HCP is declared the winner. In the case of a tied score between two players having the same HCP the players shall draw lots.
- II.7. Tournaments played under the **Texas Scramble** scoring system are played pursuant to the Rules of golf, competition regulations of the CGF and local rules. Starting from holes number 1 and 10, players proceed in succession pursuant to the roster. Rules:

It is a competition of teams of four (one flight). Each player tees off and then they all decide which shot was longest or most advantageous. Each player then plays his/her second shot from this place. They shall proceed in the same manner until the ball is putted. The team

shall record the overall shots played at each hole. The team with the lowest number of shots (upon HCP adjustment) is declared the winner.

Note: The position of the selected ball is marked with a tee (in bunkers or on the fairway) or with a marker (on the green). Players in the rough or hazards drop the ball as close to the marked position as possible, not closer to the hole. Players on the fairway or on the green shall position their ball as close to the marked position as possible, not closer to the hole.

HCP adjustment in the Texas Scramble scoring system:

Flights can even have three or two members.

One-third of the average HCP is subtracted from the overall team result.

E.g.: team result – **75 shots**

Players' HCP – $3.2 + 14.9 + 37 + 44 = 99.1 : 4 = 24.8 : 3 = 8.27$

Adjusted result: $75 - 8 =$ **67 shots**

- II.8.** Players must observe the time limits defined by the Provider. Should a group of players be more than one hole behind the group in front of them, causing uncomfortable delay to the group behind them, the Provider may order the group to skip the current hole and proceed with the next to follow. Should the group fail to comply, the Provider has the right to expel the group from the tournament.
- II.9.** Players must be at the start 10 minutes prior to the defined time. In the case of a delay of under five minutes the player shall receive two penalty strokes. In the case of a longer delay the Provider has the right to expel the player from the tournament.
- II.10.** The use of electric EZ-GO carts on the course is forbidden.

III.

Protests and objections

- III.1.** The members of the tournament committee are: Milan Heidler, Marie Dostálová and Luboš Hübner (hereinafter referred to as the "**Committee**").
- III.2.** Official protests and objections regarding tournament results must be submitted to the Committee, subject to the payment of a fee in the amount of CZK 500.
- III.3.** The Committee has the right to disqualify from the overall *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* evaluation any player who fails to comply with the conditions of the *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* or with the principles of golf etiquette.

- III.4.** The Committee shall specify areas on which practice will be allowed on tournament days.
- III.5.** The Organiser reserves the right to expel a player from the tournament, or from the entire *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour*, if the Organiser has reason to believe the entrant is using a fraudulent handicap.
- III.6.** For the sake of fair play of individual tournaments or the entire *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour*, the Committee reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions under which individual *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour* tournaments, or the entire *2011 NATLAND Golf Tour*, for that matter, will be held.

VI.

Final provisions

- VI.1.** The Partner hereby acknowledges that the Partner has read, understood and acknowledged these Terms and conditions.
- VI.2.** The Provider reserves the right to make any changes to any individual tournament, once it has been announced. Information regarding any such changes will be made public well in advance.
